They appreciate the consideration given and agree that if there's a flurry or a snow they are not to be parked in there. The Mayor said they told these residents that if there were any complaints, this will be brought back to Council to decide whether to go to a full no posting of No Parking at Any Time or whatever Council decides. Mayor Rhome stated that the residents were unaware that there was an issue.

IX. NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Mayor Rhome informed Council that Civil Service will be at the next meeting to talk about where we are as far as new laws and items we're working on, along with the three candidates who will be the backups to the Board. The Mayor said he is still looking for one, and if anyone has a suggestion, he would entertain it. He will bring the names to the next Council meeting.
- B. Mr. Lucas suggested that Council President appoint, or get a committee of two or three people of Council to meet with the Sewer Authority and try to work things out – whether there will be a Memorandum of Understanding, whether they want to be an Operating authority, whether they'll be the same, and whether we're going to finance it or we're going to finance it. These are issues that should be worked out between Council and the Authority.

Mr. Bevec will appoint a committee at the next meeting.
